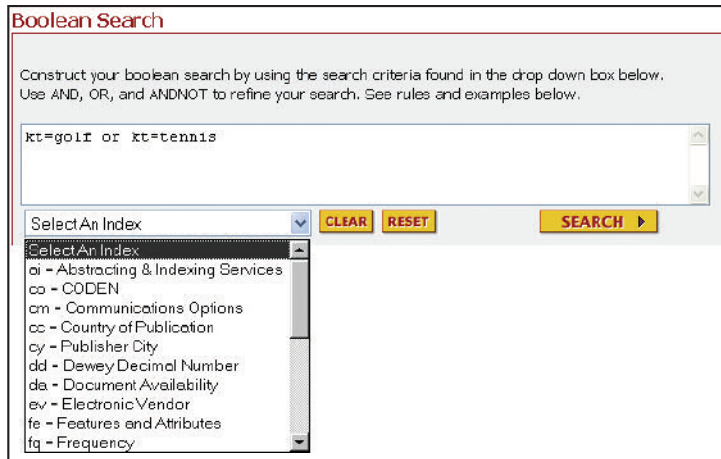


**BOOLEAN SEARCH**

- ▶ Type in a 2-character index abbreviation (or choose an index from the drop down menu).
- ▶ Type in an equals sign (=).
- ▶ Type in a search term (e.g., “golf” in the example to the right).
- ▶ To combine more than one search, use a Boolean operator (**and**, **or**, or **andnot**) between your search terms.
- ▶ Click the **Search** button and you’ll arrive at the **Search Results** screen (see page 6).

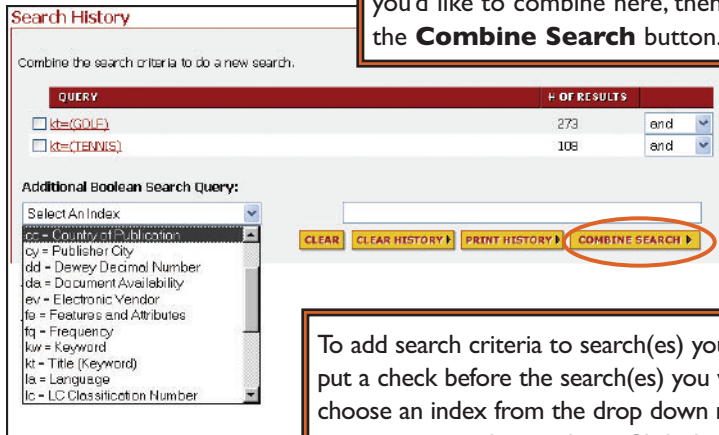


**SEARCH HISTORY**

The **Search History** screen lets you search within, or modify, a search you’ve already completed during the current session.

**Note: The Search History screen is only available if you have performed at least one search during your current ulrichsweb.com session.**

To combine searches, check the searches you’d like to combine here, then click the **Combine Search** button.



To add search criteria to search(es) you’ve already performed: put a check before the search(es) you wish to modify, then choose an index from the drop down menu, type =, then enter your search term here. Click the **Combine Search** button to complete your revised search.

**BROWSE SEARCH**

Click **Browse** in the top navigation bar from any screen in **ulrichsweb.com** to arrive here.

Simply click an index to view the contents of that index. Click “Electronic Vendor,” for example, and you’ll arrive at a list of all vendors listed in **ulrichsweb.com** that supply content in an electronic format (such as online or on CD-ROM). Click a vendor name for a list of all the titles for which that vendor supplies text electronically.
